#### 2. Student Emergency Financial Support | Presenter: Ms. Roberts

ET Lead:

GFC MSU no longer has access to the PASS Grant, which provided emergency funds to students impacted by unexpected financial difficulties. Ms. Roberts noted we do have some funds at the foundation, but most are in an endowment and would max out annually at ~\$1,000. Ms. Bonilla will visit with the Office of Student Engagement to see if the GFC MSU Associated Students would be willing to allocate funds toward a student emergency fund. It is recommended the process for awarding funds to students be similar to that of the PASS Grant, which is a selecting group that includes administration, staff, and student representatives.
