The Commissioner of Higher Education provided a letter to all students in the Montana University System. The letter was sent by Dr. Wolff to our students on Friday. Dr. Wolff sent out to all students with a message clarifying our fall semester will begin as normal with face-to-face, hybrid, and online classes. We are working closely with the MUS, as well as with state and local government, public health officials, and law enforcement, in order to make the best decisions to safeguard the health and safety of our students and campus community. The MUS Healthy Task Force will develop broad guidelines for campuses to follow when opening in the fall. GFC will continue to provide top quality services and classes to our students.

3. Summer Semester Presenter: Ms. Bonilla ET Lead:

The building will be open during regular business hours during summer semester. It will not be open to the general public. Employees with prox cards will be able to access campus on weekends during regular building, as there will be facilities staff onsite. Advisors will meet with students face-to-face and have safety protocols in place. Tables have been placed in front of desks in student central to allow for distancing. Further safety precautions are in progress, such as hand sanitizing stations and plastic dividers. Workstudy and student workers will not return to campus until fall semester.

4. Spring Courses Presenter: ET Lead:

Students in those courses needing to complete lab and clinical requirements returned to campus this week. All are following appropriate safety protocol and distancing.
