1. Academic Affairs Staffing Changes Presenter: Dr. Frost and Ms. Bonilla ET Lead:

With Stacy Lowry's acceptance of the Executive Assistant to the CEO/Dean position, the administrative duties of General Studies, Health Sciences and Trades will be covered by Jeni Luft. Jeni will be moving into R234. We may request a work study student in the fall if needed.

2. Inclusion & Diversity efforts | Presenter: Dr. Frost and Ms. Bonilla | ET Lead:

Josh Archey and Brie Menut are currently members of the inclusion and diversity group. They were tasked with researching what currently exists on campus, resources, and goals and will report at a meeting today. A third member will be added to the group.

The first on-campus vaccination clinic will be held June 30, 2021. Another clinic for the second dose if needed is July 28. Town Pump cards will be distributed at the clinics. We are considering possible incentives to encourage vaccinations.

4. Other Presenter: Various ET Lead:

Staffing: ET approved (via electronic vote) filling the Financial Aid Specialist I position.

Enrollment: Fall enrollment (FTE of 272) is up, but lags behind 2019 FTE of 350. We are looking at changing the MUS app to delete any colleges the student is not considering in order to more accurately reflect applications versus enrollments. Ms. Bonilla noted that dual enrollment students are enrolling earlier. Central Catholic attempted to enroll their dual enrollment students before the summer break.

5. Dental Clinic Ribbon Cutting | Presenter: Various | ET Lead:

Executive Team members discussed selecting a date for the dental clinic ribbon cutting. The ribbon cutting ceremony may be combined with a welcome for Dr. Erdmann and students and perhaps include Business After Hours. Ms. Bonilla noted that Shannon Marr will be included in the discussions.

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Russ Motschenbacher will be travelling to Billings in mid-July with Melissa Wells (Respiratory Therapy Program Director) for the OneMSU RT program.

We are looking at the possibility of adding Dental Assisting to the OneMSU grant. Also under consideration are sonography and radiology programs.
