2. University Center Update ET Lead - Dr. Pasek

- Dr. Pasek presented the University Center proposal to the OneMSU Leadership group at their retreat
- The discussion turned into a brainstorming session with positive interaction from all MSU campuses and OCHE
- It was recognized that access to a public 4-year degree in Great Falls is a challenge
- The Provost group has been tasked to determine next steps
- A meeting is being planned prior to the OneMSU Symposium with a broader audience OneMSU w/CEOs, Provosts, Registrars, Director of Admissions, CFO

3. Apprenticeships ET Lead – Dr. Pasek

- A meeting was held last week with Dr. Kirk Lacy
- We need to be mindful and think about how will apprenticeships may affect the credentials we offer
- We have developed some very good models through Health Care Montana and Lifelong Learning
- Academic Affairs is discussing the model used in Colorado and learning more about it

4. RIDE Goal ET Leads Drs. Pasek (Curriculum) & Stevens (LRBP)

- Need more information from President Cruzado to determine point persons and responsibilities
- Fiscal implications are unknown
- There will be an additional visit to Spokane
- Washington is coming here in November and will get more info then
- Dr. Stevens will talk to Terry Leist on an upcoming CFO call to determine any possible fiscal impact

5. Effective Leadership Ms. Bonilla
