What Does It Mean to Be a Vet Partner?

Students will need to complete a set number of hours at your facility to gain real-world experience. Clinical courses require 45 hours, while general courses may range around 3-10 hours, depending on the required skills. As a partner, you would welcome a student into your practice for approximately 15-to-20 hours per week.



- ✓ **Mentorship and Supervision:** Guide students through essential clinical skills as they develop competence in veterinary medicine
- ✓ **Access to Equipment:** Students will need hands-on, supervised opportunities to work with patients and equipment.
- ✓ **Recording and Documentation:** Permitting students to record video demonstrations (following confidentiality guidelines) to showcase their skills for assessment.
