Introduction & Purpose

Great Falls College MSU recognizes that students, faculty and staff use a variety of means of transportation. Although personal choice is important, the college must consider the safety and well-being of the campus community, our visitors and our property. Skateboarding, skating, bicycles, scooters and all-terrain vehicles can cause damage to property and present a strong potential for injury to those engaging in the activity as well as to the public at large. In an effort to avoid injuries to individuals and damage to property, the college has issued the following policy regarding the use of skateboards, skates (including roller skates and in-line skates), bicycles, scooters and all-terrain vehicles on campus.

Policy

Individuals are prohibited from skating or skateboarding on campus property including but, not limited to, sidewalks, stairs, and handrails. Skates and skateboards are not to be used inside of campus buildings.

The use of bicycles inside campus buildings is also prohibited. Bicycles should be stored in bicycle racks located outside campus buildings.

The use of electric scooters inside campus buildings and adjacent grass covered areas is prohibited. Scooters should be parked in areas as not to impede access to and from campus buildings.

All-terrain vehicles must be operated only on paved driveways and parking lots.

Great Falls City police officers are authorized to remove violators of this policy from Great Falls College MSU property.

Persons who violate this policy are personally liable for their actions.
